

## **SERVICE UPDATE**

## **General Liability Insurance Required for Shed and Scaffold Job Types**

Effective May 16, 2016, contractors or licensees pulling permits for shed or scaffold job types, must meet General Liability Insurance requirements by presenting proof of their \$1,000,000.00 insurance policy, in accordance with 1 RCNY 101-08.

If a contractor or licensee attempts to obtain a permit for shed or scaffold work but does not currently have \$1,000,000 in General Liability Insurance coverage, they will be instructed to obtain the coverage and present proof of the insurance policy to the Licensing Unit – after which they will be able to obtain a permit. Please review the Department's General Liability Insurance Guidelines.
