## New Electronic Joint Venture Submission Process for Licensed Master Plumbers and Licensed Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors

As of January 3, 2017 the Department has implemented a new email submission process for Licensed Master Plumbers (LMP) and Licensed Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors (LFSC) filing for Joint Venture approval.

Licensed LMPs and LFSCs **must** submit their Joint Venture requests by email to the Licensing Unit & Exam Unit at **JointVentures@buildings.nyc.gov**. All LMP & LFSC Joint Venture requests **must** comply with the following guidelines:

- Both licensees requesting Joint Venture approval from the Department must submit a signed and sealed letter of request on their company letterhead and include the following items:
  - the name and license number of both licensees, companies entering the Joint Venture, and their email addresses;
  - a statement that the project is being filed as a Joint Venture and that both Licensees agree;
  - the address of the project and the Joint Venture permit number;
  - the name, company and license number of the Contractor holding the permit, insurance and/or bond; and
  - a statement that all work will be under the direct supervision of both companies and Licensees, all inspections and tests may be conducted by either company.

NOTE: If these conditions are not met, the Joint Venture request will not be processed.

 Email subject line and PDF file must be properly named with the same details (subject line and PDF file: joint venture project address\_ permit number\_1<sup>st</sup> license# & 2<sup>nd</sup> license#)

## Example:

If the Joint Venture project address is 1 Arthur Avenue, and the job number is 123456789, the subject line should read '1 Arthur Avenue\_123456789\_LMP1842 & LMP2339'.

You will be notified by email once your Joint Venture request has been processed.
