Local Law 28 of 2019: Penalties and Violations for Certain Accessory Signs

As of February 9, 2019, the Department will not impose civil penalties for work without a permit violations for business storefront signs that neither exceed 150 square feet in area nor exceed 1,200 pounds in weight.

Respondents who received these violations on or after December 28, 2017, and have not paid the penalties, may submit a request for a waiver of these penalties. Applicants requesting this waiver must submit the updated <u>L2 Form</u> dated 02/19, available on the Department's web site, at a <u>Borough Office</u>.

Moratorium on Issuance of Certain Accessory Sign Violations

From February 9, 2019, through February 9, 2021, the Department will not issue violations for business storefront signs that existed on or before February 9, 2019, unless the sign creates an imminent threat to public health or safety or the Commissioner of the Department of Buildings determines that the sign is not otherwise eligible for the moratorium.
