



Dear Provider Partners,

We are pleased to write that you have been awarded a City Council Discretionary Contract for a one time increase in operating expenses, including personnel, related to COVID-19 and returning to work. This funding is based on the City's \$24 million investment in human services nonprofits that was allocated in the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget.

The funding was awarded to nonprofit providers that have current contracts with the City of New York. The amount of funding per organization was determined as a proportion of each organization's total current contract value. The awards will be approved on a rolling basis through City Council Transparency Resolutions beginning with the September 23, 2021 Transparency Resolution and will be processed as City Council Discretionary contracts. Each provider will have a single contract that is processed by one of their current contracting agencies. The funding may be used flexibly by your organization for personnel or other expenses. You can find City Council Transparency Resolutions on the Council Website [here](#). Once approved through a Transparency Resolution, your organization's contract will be processed in PASSPort.

We appreciate your ongoing partnership and recognize your commitment to our City always and especially during the last eighteen months.
