
Mr. Fariello:

The Grantee's modification request of June 4, 2013 to: 1) extend the Grant Period to December 31, 2013, 2) request supplemental funding of \$23,314,255, 3) increase the number of participants to 2,902, and 4) submission of the fully documented plan is approved. In addition, the Grantee's request to exceed the wage limitation for four temporary job positions at NYC Homeless Services is also approved as a one-time exception. The revised budget and plan is partially approved. See incoming Grantee request, which is incorporated by reference.

The Grantee is advised that \$20,494,622 of this supplemental award is funded with appropriations made available under the Disaster Relief Appropriations Act (P.L. 113-2). These funds are only available for 18 months from the date of execution. The Grantee is further advised that it may not use the supplemental funding appropriated under P.L. 113-2 for expenditures incurred prior to January 29, 2013, the date that the supplemental funds became available for Federal obligation. The remainder of this supplemental award (\$2,819,633) is funded with Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 Advance funds.
