This performance report compares information on the placement of children from the community district (CD) of this report in the borough of this report as compared to those from the borough and the city as a whole. The best indicator of success at neighborhood-based placement is the rate at which children placed in regular foster boarding homes (FBHs) are placed in their home CD. This report focuses on two perspectives: (1) level of care; and (2) sibling groups.
