

Indicator 2: Neighborhood-Based Placements, Borough Summary

This indicator provides a measure of the foster care system's success at placing children in their own communities. This performance report focuses on placements of children from the borough of this report. This report uses community districts (CD) as a proxy for neighborhood. The best indicator of success at neighborhood-based placement is the rate at which children placed in regular¹ foster boarding homes (FBHs) are placed in their home CD. This report focuses on two perspectives: (1) level of care; and (2) sibling groups.

The first perspective, which is shown on this page, shows the rate at which children placed in regular FBHs are placed in their home CDs. It also considers placement into home CD for children placed in kinship care and placement into home borough for regular and specialized² FBH, kinship and congregate care placements.
