

Outcome 6:**Increase Permanency For Adolescents, Borough**

This outcome provides measures of the foster care system's success at moving adolescents (children 12 years and older) from the borough of this report into permanent homes on a timely basis. This performance report focuses on three perspectives: 1) the status of adolescents placed in annual admissions cohorts;¹ 2) placements of adolescents; and 3) adolescents in care at a given point in time.

The first perspective, shown on this page and the second page of this report, looks at the status of adolescents placed in annual admissions cohorts. The best indicators of success at achieving increased permanency from this perspective are the percent discharged to reunification² and the percent discharged to adoption. This page provides information on adolescents admitted to their first spell³ in foster care and the next page considers cohorts of adolescents in their second or greater spells. For each year the number of adolescents placed in foster care and their age group at time of admission are provided. The remaining indicators in this report consider the status of these cohorts as of a set point in time following the end of each admission year. For those still in care, the most current Permanency Planning Goal (PPG)⁴ is provided. For adolescents that have been discharged, information on discharge destination and time in care are provided.

³ A spell is the time between foster care entry and discharge. A child's 1st spell is her/his 1st episode in foster care. Subsequent episodes in foster care are 2nd or greater spells.

⁴ Permanency Planning Goal (PPG) refers to a goal that must be specified for every child in foster care at all times.

This performance report focuses on three perspectives: 1) the status of adolescents placed in annual admissions cohorts;¹ 2) placements of adolescents; and 3) adolescents in care at a given point in time.

The first perspective, shown on this page and the second page of this report, looks at the status of adolescents placed in annual admissions cohorts. The best indicators of success at achieving increased permanency from this perspective are the percent discharged to reunification² and the percent discharged to adoption. This page provides information on adolescents admitted to their first spell³ in foster care and the next page considers cohorts of adolescents in their second or greater spells. For each year the number of adolescents placed in foster care and their age group at time of admission are provided. The remaining indicators in this report consider the status of these cohorts as of a set point in time following the end of each admission year. For those still in care, the most current Permanency Planning Goal (PPG)⁴ is provided. For adolescents that have been discharged, information on discharge destination and time in care are provided.
