Adult Educators Meet in All Day Conference

On Saturday, May 7th, 2011, adult educators from all over the Tri-State area and beyond will meet at **Fashion Industries High School at 225 West 24th Street in Manhattan** for the annual Adult Basic Education Conference. This year, there will be a special plenary discussion from the New York Literacy Assistance Center and workshops from the Mayor's Office of Adult Education and the YMCA. For ESL, ABE and GED learners, there will be a wide variety of workshops exploring best practices in ESL instruction and GED/Pre-GED/BE math, reading and writing, and the Spanish GED. BE and GED math workshops will range from basic math to geometry, math and finance, and GED math. "Using the GED Compass" will showcase the latest online resources for students, teachers and policy makers. ESL workshops will include: exploring multilevel classroom success, health literacy in the ESL classroom, immigrants' right to work, vocabulary building and grammar. There will also be a workshop from the Lower East Side Tenement Museum, "Using History to Teach English." Publishers will present two workshops, "Using the TABE" and "Multilevel Instruction." The Mayor's Office of Adult Education will offer "Using the 'We Are New York' Video Show in the Classroom." There will also be workshops in instructional technology, including "Social Media Tools in Adult Education" and "Using iTunes to Integrate Video into the ESL Classroom." The workshop "Serving the L.B.G.T. Community in Adult Education" will be offered to learners, teachers and program directors. Program directors and adult educators are encouraged to invite their students interested in student leadership, community building, and ESL/ABE transition-to-college to take part in the conference.
