

Street Closings for 9/11 Memorial Ceremonies

Given the limited vehicle and pedestrian access in the Lower Manhattan vicinity, we ask that you encourage your employees to:

- Avoid scheduling deliveries or pickups on September 11th until after 5:00 PM;

Below is an outline of the **vehicle and pedestrian access** information for this area on **Friday, September 11, 2009**.

Liberty Street between Broadway and Church Street/Trinity Place
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic; **limited** pedestrian access.

Liberty Street Pedestrian Bridge will be closed. To cross West Street pedestrians will be directed north to use the Vesey Street Pedestrian Bridge or south to Albany / Carlisle Streets.

Albany Street between Greenwich and West Streets
CLOSED to vehicles, parking, traffic **AND** pedestrians.

Carlisle Street between Greenwich and West Streets
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic
OPEN to pedestrians

Thames Street between Broadway and Greenwich Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic
OPEN to pedestrians

Cedar Street between Broadway and Church/Trinity Place
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic; **limited** pedestrian access.

Church Street/Trinity Place between Battery Place to Barclay Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic; **limited** pedestrian access. Traffic will be diverted to West Street.

Cortlandt Street between Broadway and Church Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic; **limited** pedestrian access.

Dey Street between Broadway and Church Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic
OPEN to pedestrians

Fulton Street between Broadway and Church Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic
OPEN to pedestrians

Vesey Street between Broadway and Church Street
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic
OPEN to pedestrians

Barclay Street between Broadway and West Streets
CLOSED to vehicles, parking and traffic

OPEN to pedestrians

Murray Street from West to Church Streets

Greenwich Street from Warren to Barclay Streets

Park Place from West Broadway to Greenwich Streets

West Broadway from Warren to Barclay Streets

CLOSED to parking

OPEN to pedestrians

Warren Street between West Street and Broadway

OPEN to vehicles and traffic

NO PARKING

OPEN to pedestrians

No parking will be in effect on all closed streets, including **official permit parking**. All cars parked illegally will be towed.

Note that **West Street** and **Broadway** will be the prime uptown and downtown traffic thoroughfares on September 11th from 12:00 AM to 4:00 PM so please allow enough time for travel.
