
## Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)

To verify the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) for your qualifying truck(s), please attach a photograph of the sticker located on the inside of the driver's side doorframe showing the Manufacturer's GVWR. One photograph of the GVWR is required per truck.

Below is an example of where the sticker is located. The GVWR is highlighted in the rectangle.



The following are additional examples of GVWR labels from different manufacturers. The GVWR can be found in the highlighted rectangle.







## Locating the EPA Engine Family Name (EFN) and Engine Specifications

The EPA engine family name is a 12 character number/letter designation included on the engine nameplate for all heavy duty truck engines. The nameplate, or sticker, is permanently affixed to the engine. The exact location and appearance of the sticker varies by engine manufacturer. Examples of nameplates from three major engine manufacturers are included below:

### Caterpillar Engine Example:



Caterpillar Nameplate (2 labels): EPA Family Name – 5CPXH0928EBK  
 Engine Model Year - 2005  
 Engine Horsepower – 475 HP


## Locating the EPA Engine Family Name (EFN) and Engine Specifications (Continued)

### Cummins Engine Example:



Cummins Nameplate: EPA Family Name – 4CEXH0912XAJ  
Engine Model Year - 2004  
Engine Horsepower – 400 HP

### Detroit Diesel Engine Example:



Detroit Diesel Nameplate: EPA Family Name – 5DDXH14.0ELY  
Engine Model Year - 2005  
Engine Horsepower – 515 HP
