COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensee or Registrant:

Street access will be restricted in Manhattan in the area of Times Square in preparation for New Year's Eve. The following streets in Manhattan will be closed to all vehicles Saturday, December 31, 2011 through the morning of Sunday, January 1, 2012:

- Seventh Avenue, from 41st to 59th Streets;
- Broadway, from 47th to 59th Streets;
- 43rd to 47th Streets, from Sixth to Eighth Avenues;
- 42nd Street from Sixth to Eighth Avenues;
- All cross-town streets from 37th to 41st Streets - Sixth to Eighth Avenues;
- All cross-town streets from 49th to 59th Streets - Sixth to Eighth Avenues; and
- 48th Street, from Fifth to Ninth Avenues.

Accordingly, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to remove all waste from any of your stops located on the streets above before 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 31, 2011.** Notify all customers on these streets that waste must be placed curbside before 10:00 a.m. No waste may be placed curbside between 10:00 a.m., Saturday, December 31, 2011 through 12:00 p.m. (noon), Sunday, January 1, 2012. NYPD barricades will be in place to prepare Times Square for New Year's Eve, and there will be no vehicle access for waste pickup.

Also, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to remove any of your company's containers that are in the streets above.** You are advised that there is a NYC Department of Transportation construction embargo in effect in the above area that prohibits containers in the affected streets. Failure to abide by this Directive may result in administrative fines up to \$10,000 (*See*, 17 RCNY § 1-09), and may be considered in evaluating the status of your company's License or Registration.
