COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensee or Registrant:

In observance of the opening of the 9/11 Memorial Museum on May 15, 2014, street access will be restricted near the area of memorial on that day. The following perimeter in lower Manhattan will be restricted access to accommodate the memorial:

- Liberty, Cedar, and Thames Streets between Greenwich Street and Broadway
- Trinity Place between Cortlandt and Rector Streets
- Greenwich Street between Liberty and Carlisle Streets
- Washington Street between Liberty and Carlisle Streets
- Albany and Carlisle Streets between Washington and Greenwich Streets
- Vesey Street between Church Street and Broadway

Accordingly, YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to remove all waste on the streets above before 2:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 15, 2014. No waste may be collected between 2:00 a.m. Thursday, May 15, 2014 and 1:00 pm on Thursday, May 15, 2014. Uniformed BIC officers will patrol the area to ensure compliance with this Directive.

You are also advised that a NYC Department of Transportation construction embargo is in effect in the above area and additional streets. See this link for more information about the embargo:
