**COMMISSION DIRECTIVE**

Dear Licensee or Registrant:

In observance of the anniversary of September 11<sup>th</sup>, street access will be restricted near the area of memorial services on that day. The following perimeter in lower Manhattan will be restricted access to accommodate the memorial:

- Areas bounded by Chambers Street on the north; Battery Place on the south; Broadway on the east; West Street on the west; all inclusive
- Washington Street, from Liberty Street to Battery Place;
- Church Street/Trinity Place from Reade Street to Morris Street;
- Morris Street from West Street to Washington Street;
- State Street from Battery Place to Whitehall Street;
- Liberty Street from Broadway to Nassau Street;
- Liberty Street from West Street to South End Avenue;
- Cedar Street from Broadway to Nassau Street;
- Pine Street from Broadway to Nassau Street;
- Nassau Street from Liberty Street to Pine Street

Accordingly, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED** that **all waste on the streets above must be removed before 12:01 am on Saturday, September 11, 2010**. Waste service may resume at 11:59 pm that day.

Also, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED** to **remove any containers in the streets above before 12:01 am Saturday, September 4, 2010**. Containers may not be replaced until 11:59 pm on Saturday, September 11, 2010. You are advised there will be a NYC Department of Transportation construction embargo in effect in the above area beginning September 4, 2010. Uniformed BIC officers will be onsite to ensure compliance with this Directive. A map showing the restricted area is enclosed for your reference. The map and a copy of this Directive are also available at [nyc.gov/bic](http://nyc.gov/bic).

Failure to abide by this Directive may result in administrative fines up to \$10,000 (*See*, 17 RCNY §1-09), and may be considered in evaluating the status of your company's License or Registration.
