Re: Wholesale Business Registration

Dear Business Owner:

The Business Integrity Commission (“Commission”) is the New York City agency that regulates, among other things, the City’s public wholesale markets and wholesale businesses. The Commission investigates businesses, their owners, and employees to ensure that only those with good character, honesty, and integrity are permitted to operate in designated areas of the City of New York. The Commission also collects data about the industries it regulates and facilitates communication between the wholesale food industry and the City.

Under the provisions of Title 66 Rules of the City of New York Chapter 1 Subchapter A and other applicable law, wholesalers and market businesses in the area adjacent to the New York City Terminal Produce Co-operative Market are required to register with the Commission. Businesses must register with the Commission in the near future by filling out a Wholesale Business Registration Application. Before a license or registration is granted, the Commission conducts background investigations of the applicant business and its principals.

To assist you with registration, the Commission will hold an information session at Community Board 2 located at 1027 East 163rd Street, Bronx, NY at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30th and Wednesday, July 1st. Representatives from the Commission will be available to answer your questions and to distribute applications.
