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COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensee or Registrant:

Street access will be restricted in Manhattan along the route of the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade. The following streets in Manhattan will be closed to all vehicles beginning the evening of Wednesday, November 23, 2011:

- Columbus Avenue between 81st Street and 77th Street
- Central Park West between 81st Street and 86th Street
- 81st Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue
- 77th Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue
- 76th Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue
- 71st Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue
- Central Park West between 81st Street and East Side of Columbus Circle /59th Street
- Broadway between 59th Street and 58th Street
- 58th Street between Broadway and 7th Avenue
- 59th Street between Columbus Circle and 7th Avenue
- 7th Avenue between 59th Street and 42nd Street
- 46th Street between 7th Avenue and 6th Avenue
- 42nd Street between 7th Avenue and 6th Avenue
- 6th Avenue between 42nd Street and 34th Street
- 34th Street between 6th Avenue and 7th Avenue
- 33rd Street between 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue
- 34th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue
- 35th Street between 6th Avenue and 8th Avenue
- 36th Street between Broadway and 8th Avenue
- 37th Street between Broadway and 8th Avenue
- 38th Street between Broadway and 8th Avenue
- 39th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue
- 40th Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue
- 7th Avenue between 33rd Street and 40th Street

Accordingly, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to remove all waste from any of your stops located on the streets above before 10:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23, 2011.** All customers must be notified that NYPD barricades will be in place for the Thanksgiving Day Parade and there will be no


vehicle access for waste pickup. Additionally, all customers on these streets must be notified that waste must be placed curbside before 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23, 2011; that no waste may be placed curbside between 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 through 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 24, 2011; and, that waste collection shall resume as usual at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 24, 2011.

In addition, **YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to remove any of your company's containers that are in the streets above.** You are advised that there is a NYC Department of Transportation construction embargo in effect from November 14, 2011 through November 24, 2011 in the above area that prohibits containers in the affected streets. Uniformed BIC officers will be onsite to ensure compliance with this Directive. A map showing the restricted area is enclosed for your reference. The map and a copy of this Directive are also available at nyc.gov/bic.

Failure to abide by this Directive may result in administrative fines up to \$10,000 (*See*, 17 RCNY § 1-09), and may be considered in evaluating the status of your company's License or Registration.
