**THE BUSINESS INTEGRITY COMMISSION ANNOUNCES THE ARRESTS OF TWO EMPLOYEES OF NJC CARTING CORPORATION FOLLOWING THE THEFT OF A COMPETITOR'S CONTAINER.**

New York City Business Integrity Commission Commissioner Shari C. Hyman announced the arrests today of two employees of NJC Carting Corporation in connection with the theft of a competitor's container in the Bronx. The arrests of Anthony Glover and Nelson Quinones occurred at NJC Carting Corporation garage at 464 Hunts Point Ave. The value of the stolen container is between \$300-500. Both men were charged with petit larceny and processed at the 41<sup>st</sup> precinct.

Commissioner Hyman stated, "The theft of a competitor's property is an unconscionable act which violates the fundamental principles of honest free market conduct the Business Integrity Commission protects. These arrests confirm that there is zero tolerance for this type of criminal activity. I want to thank the NYPD for their partnership in our ongoing efforts to root out criminal activity in the carting industry."

The investigation was conducted by Det. Larry McQueen and Sanitation Police Officer Jeffery Makhmaltchi under the supervision of BIC Director of Investigations Christopher Mahon and Lt. Christopher Murphy of the New York City Police Department Organized Crime Investigation Division.

Arrest charges and criminal complaints are merely accusations. Defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
