AGENDA:

(1.) **PRESENTATION** - Ash Street Project: The scope of the project is to improve the public realm, enhancing pedestrian and bicycle safety, and have sustainable elements to capture storm water. The primary objective of creating Greenways is to encourage a healthy lifestyle and promote a higher quality of urban life by providing a safe convenient and enjoyable venue for active recreation and the use of non-motorized forms of transportation. Green ways expand recreational opportunities for walking, jogging, biking, and in-line skating – presented by NYC DOT and NYC DDC.

(2.) **PRESENTATION** - Informational Briefing on the Brooklyn Queens Connector (BQX): NYCEDC and DOT are working diligently on the BQX - Brooklyn Queens Connector first unveiled by Mayor de Blasio in his 2016 State of the City address. Over the last year the two agencies have made progress in several key areas. They have completed a rapid assessment and embarked on a comprehensive feasibility study and alternatives analysis to support implementation of the 16-mile BQX corridor - presented by NYC EDC
