1. **PRESENTATION:** South 5th Place and the connection with the Williamsburg Bridge bike path: NYC DOT, Aaron Frait.

The Bicycle Program has a 2015 SIP that includes improvements to South 5th Place and the connection with the Williamsburg Bridge bike path.

2. **PRESENTATION:** Greenpoint Avenue Traffic Flow and Safety Project: NYC DOT, Craig Baerwald

The proposed Greenpoint Avenue project offers an improvement in traffic flow with the installation of a second travel lane in the westbound direction from Greenpoint Avenue Bridge to Provost Street, and relocating the bike lane curbside with a buffer. In the eastbound direction, the bike lane will be relocated curbside west of Humboldt Street to the bridge and include a buffer. In conjuncture with the proposed improvements on Greenpoint Ave, the Greenpoint Ave Bridge project that was presented to the community several years ago but was delayed due to construction activity includes bicycle lanes that offer an important

eastbound and westbound bicycle route across the bridge. This would improve a critical link by connecting to an existing facility on the Brooklyn side to an existing facility in Queens on Van Dam St, and eventually a proposed facility on Greenpoint Ave in Queens.
