

Wilson Avenue L Station Capital Project

This is to update you on MTA NYC Transit's construction project at the Wilson Avenue L station in Brooklyn. MTA NYC Transit originally presented this project to Brooklyn Community Board 4 in October 2014. Completed in 1928, the Wilson Avenue station was built as a part of the Dual-Contract BMT system. The ongoing station project will restore the exterior façade of the station entrance based on historic photographs and original drawings for the station design, including the replacement and installation of doors and windows. The interior finishes of the station entrance will be repaired and replicated where missing. New exterior lighting will help light up the newly restored station, as well as provide much-needed illumination in the approach to the station. An ADA ramp will provide access to the station for the Manhattanbound platform. The alternate service plan associated with this capital program work will commence on April 18, 2016 and continue until May 31, 2016. During this period, L trains will not stop at the Wilson Avenue station in either direction. A loop shuttle bus will operate continuously between the Wilson Avenue and Broadway Junction stations, stopping at the Bushwick-Avenue-Aberdeen Street L station as well. This fare-free shuttle bus will operate every 5 minutes from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. every day, and every 10 minutes at other times. Once normal train service is restored to the Wilson Avenue station, customers will be able to safely access the station. However, our contractor will continue to perform construction work at the station, which will be completed in Summer 2016. Service notices will be posted at the Wilson Avenue station and along the L line in order to inform customers of this service plan. As always, customers can contact station personnel or refer to our website at www.mta.info for any additional changes to service. MTA NYC Transit is looking forward to providing customers and the community with a greatly-improved Wilson Avenue station, and we appreciate your patience as we perform the work.
