

## AMENDMENTS TO MINUTES OF APRIL 14, 2011 MEETING

**Economic Development Committee** – As per State Liquor Authority (SLA), instructions, the agency does not want to be informed of licensees that are in compliance with the Community Board’s new regulations; they are only concerned with those establishments, where the Board is requesting that the license not be renewed. This request will always be accompanied by a justification.

Moe and Vibano’s Trattoria had signed the stipulations as of April 12, 2011.

As of April 14, 2011, the representatives from Paddy Doherty’s submitted the signed stipulation form. Again, the SLA is not interested in receiving a letter from this Board, approving renewals for those establishments that signed the stipulations. Therefore no letter will be sent, rendering the following resolutions null and void.

“Resolution...Be it resolved that Community Board #10 recommend that a letter of approval be sent to State Liquor Authority (SLA) for International Caterers of 3423 Ampere Avenue and Shelly’s Bar BQ as they ha have signed and complied with the stipulations.” Motion to accept made by Mr. Talarico, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Ribustelo-Votes 23 in favor, 2 Abstentions-Mr. Santiago and Mrs. Lask

“Resolution...Be it resolved that Community Board #10 send a letter stating that Paddy Doherty’s Ale House has not signed the stipulation by the deadline and his application for renewal of liquor license should be denied”. Motion to accept made by Mr. Blacovitch and seconded by Mr. Santiago-Vote 21 in favor, 4 abstentions-Mrs. Jack; Mrs. Lask; Mrs. Gallagher; Ms. Burrowes.

“Resolution...Be it resolved that Community Board #10 send a letter asking for the denial of a liquor license for Paddy Doherty’s Ale House, as they have not signed the stipulation or attended the server class.” Motion to accept made by Mr. Talarico and seconded by Mr. Picoli. Vote 19 in favor, 1 opposed- Mr. Goldstein; 5 abstenstentions- Mrs. Jack; Mrs. Lask; Mrs. Gallagher; Ms. Burrowes and Mr. Santiago.
