Individuals must be deceased or terminally ill. Proposed civic organizations must be a not-for-profit organization and an active group performing community public service.

- If your application is voted down by the Board, an application for the proposed honoree cannot be submitted or resubmitted for a minimum of three (3) years following the rejection. Only under extraordinary circumstances can the waiting period be waived.

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
