## 1. New Business

a. FY2018 Needs Statement: The committee discussed the form and the particular needs of the community from the public safety viewpoint. Committee asked police reps what needs they may have. Committee believes fostering public safety, and police/community relation is important. Needs includes: increased anti-drug education programs for community youth; graffiti removal system (committee to discuss with Senator Klein's Office and coordinate); increased police presence in community events for youth outreach development such as sports tournaments, game-offs; 49th pct. Would benefit from bikes to increase patrol.
