HUMAN RIGHTS LAW

The NYC Human Right Law includes anti-discrimination provisions in employment, housing and, public accommodations, as well as protections against discriminatory harassment and bias-based policing.

STOP CREDIT DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT ACT

Under the Stop Credit Discrimination in Employment Act, most employers in New York City are prohibited from checking applicants' credit history to make employment decisions.

FAIR CHANCE ACT

The Fair Chance Act makes it illegal for employers in New York City to ask about criminal history before making a job offer.

The Commission works with organizations, advocates and community leaders to provide free Know Your Obligations workshops at its borough-based community service centers and other locations.
