• Bronx Community Board #8 and Community Leaders Applaud CSX's Clean-Up of Putnam South Property


Bronx Community Board #8 held an event on October 26th to mark the completion of a massive clean-up effort of CSX's ³/₄-mile-long Putnam South property, adjacent to the Major Deegan Expressway from Van Cortlandt Park South to West 230th Street. This project was done by CSX Transportation at the request of the Community Board and involved months of intense garbage and debris clean up, path-clearing and graffiti removal for the length of the property.

The City is currently negotiating with CSX to acquire an easement to convert the CSX right of way into a rail-totrail greenway leading to Van Cortlandt Park from West 230th Street. Rodney Oglesby, resident vice president for state government affairs for CSX, said, "CSX would be pleased to see this property re-purposed for recreational uses by residents of the Van Cortlandt and Kingsbridge community. We look forward to continuing our dialog with the city in hopes of identifying a path forward in that process."

Senator Jeffrey Klein, Assemblyman Jeffrey Dinowitz, and Bronx Parks Commissioner Iris Rodriguez-Rosa, government representatives, community board members, involved community organizations and CSX attended the recognition event.

Henry Hudson Bridge Project

The Henry Hudson Bridge project to install lightpoles and to perform electrical and roadway work commenced on October 20. The northbound (to Bronx) lane on the Henry Hudson Parkway from Dyckman Street entrance to the former toll plaza area on the bridge's upper level will be closed for about 5 months. The long-term single-lane southbound closure on the lower level will start in January 2018.

Leafs are to be placed in the leaf bags or in an unlined, open container and be put out to be collected on the designated organics collection day for your neighborhood. • DSNY Collection Request for Large Items

DSNY is now asking anyone that has non-recyclable objects larger than 4 x 3 feet to please schedule an appointment for the items to be picked up. To schedule an appointment for collection, you may call 311 or visit nyc.gov/bulk. DSNY urges that you please make sure that the items can be picked up by two people and that it will fit in the garbage truck. • DSNY is now hiring Emergency Snow Laborers

Registration has begun for emergency snow laborers for the upcoming snow season. Snow laborers are Perdiem workers who are called upon to remove snow and ice citywide from bus stops, crosswalks, fire hydrants and step streets in the City after heavy snowfalls.

Individuals interested in registering with the DSNY can do so at their local district garage weekdays between 7:00AM and 3:00PM. To see a list of garage locations, **click here.** Laborers will be paid \$15.00 per hour, and \$22.50 per hour after 40 hours are worked in a week. Snow laborers must be at least 18 years of age, be eligible to work in the United States, and able to perform heavy physical labor. • Freeze Your Rent SCRIE Application Forms Available at Bronx Community Board No. 8

The Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE) program offers eligible tenants an exemption from rent increases. To be eligible for SCRIE, you must be 62 or older, have a household income of \$50,000 or less after allowable deductions and lease a rent controlled apartment, rent stabilized apartment or rent regulated hotel/SRO that costs at least one third of your monthly household income.

If eligible and approved, NYC freezes your rent either at your prior rent amount or 1/3 of your monthly household income, whichever is greater The City of New York compensates the owner of the building by providing a corresponding credit against their real estate taxes.

The application form contains additional eligibility and process information. You can obtain an application by: picking one up at the CB8 office located at 5676 Riverdale Avenue, Suite 100, dialing 311 or by **clicking here**.



• DRIE Announcement from the NYC Department of Finance (DOF)

Disability Rent Increase Exemption (DRIE) recipients whose benefits have been expired for at least six months might be entitled to have their benefits restored if

they have remained eligible to participate in the program. DOF mailed applications to eligible households and authorized third-party tenant representatives. Eligible DRIE recipients should submit a renewal application and all required supporting documentation by January 19, 2018. The application is also available online or at any of the Department of Finance's five Business Centers. Click here for further information.


