Vice Chairperson's Report:

Discussion and update on trolley progress. Two separate routes were discussed: (2) all in one loop with trolley traveling along the commercial establishments on Riverdale Ave., starting either in the vicinity of W. 256 St. or W. 236 St., go to the Johnson Ave. business area and then proceed towards W. 231 St. ending near Broadway. The trolley would reverse itself starting in the vicinity of W. 231 St. & Broadway and travel back towards Riverdale Ave. or (2) one trolley for Kingsbridge and one trolley for Riverdale. Whichever route is eventually considered the MTA will be consulted about the overlap with buses.

Mr. Palumbo has graciously donated Palumbo's Café on Riverdale Avenue for the next committee meeting. A presentation by Prof. Poo of Monroe College will be conducted on "Students in Free Enterprise" - matches students with businesses to assist in technical advancement.

Discussion had on the increased quantity of inspections made by several agencies to Riverdale Ave. business establishment.
