Introductions were made because of new attendees at meeting.

Emily Falber, our speaker from Riverdale Neighborhood House began the meeting engaging all to a conversation regarding "Bullying in Schools". Ms. Farber does clinical work at RMHA with 4 and 6 year olds and is involved with the middle school and high school at RKA. She gave her opinion as to why there is so much bullying going on at such a young age. Socialization is limited because of technology which is isolating, parents involvement in social issues so children do not have to cope on their own and administration in schools leave volatile matters to overburdened guidance counselors and some problems fall through the cracks and surface in violence. Schools need to address confrontations immediately to prevent future student problems.

Patrick Meenaghan and Kristine Rivera have applied to the state to open their third Bronx Charter School for Excellence (site not chosen yet). They are now running two Charter Schools on Benedict Avenue and have a successful model which they hope to duplicate in their future school. Children are admitted by lottery and include special education students. Their key elements of the Education model include: High academic standards focused on preparing scholars for high performing high schools, college and jobs in the future. The Committee was very impressed with the presentation. There was some discussion of the situation with PS 24.

The budget was not addressed by laid over to our next meeting on May 31, 2016.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 PM.
