Introductions were made because of new attendees at meeting.

Jasmine and Daniel Williams started their presentation of their proposed new Charter School Academy of Leadership and Free Enterprise. Their mission is to cognitively, emotionally and socially develop young men committed to the pursuit of excellence in leadership and entrepreneurship. To date there is no charter school that serves an all male population from grades 6-12. Beginning in 10<sup>th</sup> grade the students will have access to the CTE pathway to Business and Distributive Education. They have chosen Entrepreneurial Education because it promotes social and cultural identity, builds a stronger sense of community, gives youth, especially at risk youth, a sense of meaning and belonging, creates entrepreneurial thinkers, and greatly improves economic and financial literacy. They chose District' 10 because of its diversity and is located in one of the safest neighborhoods in the city. They are at stage two of the process and greatly appreciated the members input. They will return to the committee in the future.

Overcrowding at local schools was discussed but no conclusions were decided upon. Administrations of the schools are working with DOE to come up with a plan for the near future.

The Participatory Budget of Councilman Cohen was discussed and will be voted on by the community starting March 26-April 2.

Discussion on the election of Elizabeth Rosa as Board of Regents Chancellor was enthusiastic since

Ms. Rosa is from the Bronx and is aware of the feelings of parents as to the common core curriculum. She has taught and served as Superintendent in District 10 and is very familiar with the needs of the students. It is great to have someone of her caliber in Albany tuned in to our schools.

Five of the schools in the JFK school complex were among recipients in the city of \$10.00 tickets to "Hamilton". What a great treat for the students. The schools are Bronx Engineering and Technology Academy, Bronx School of Law and Finance, ELLIS Academy, Marble Hill High School and Bronx Theatre High School.
