Remembering Our Own, Long-Term Board Member Joyce Pilsner (1925-2016)



Joyce Pilsner – September 1997

Community Board No. 8 is deeply saddened by the loss of one of its most esteemed members, Joyce Pilsner. She was appointed to the Board in 1976 and served for 40 years. In the early years she was chair of Health, Hospitals and Social Services Committee; and the Youth Services Committee. She then served as Board Chair from 1993 to 1995, Vice Chair from 1996 to 2006, and Secretary from 2007 to 2015.

Joyce was very dedicated and valued. She was strong in her efforts to protect the well-being of the community and workded hard on the Board's developemnt of the 197-a rezoning plan. She was invested in areas of mental health isues, youth and the aged.

She will be remembered as a stellar member of the community. Her contributions to CB8 were immeasurable. Her influence and intellect will be greatly missed by all.

NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygeine Report on the Zika Virus

The Department of Health and Mental Hygeine (DOHMH) has been actively informing the entire City on the Zika Virus since February 2016.

DOHMH communicated the following at CB8's April 2016 Board Meeting:

- Pregnant women should consult with their OBGYN if they plan to travel or if your partner spent time in a Zika affected area
- use insect repellants approved by the EPA, apply sunscreen first, then repellant;
- Insect repellant is safe for pregnant women
- wear long sleeves and pants and wear clothing treated with permethrin (a chemical that repels insects)
