Minutes approved.

Det. Rodriguez Report: 3 homicides for the year: in January, February and March. 2 arrests, one open. 1 rape, 20 robberies, 25 felony assaults, 24 burglaries 54 grand larcenies, 19 stolen cars. Total 156 crimes vs. 186 last year. He reminded citizens to wear seat belts while driving and to not talk on cell phones, because police are watching.

The committee approved all renewal liquor license applications before it - Uptown Sports Complex, owners present. Requesting full liquor license under the name Rain, an event space. Vote was tabled until the next meeting. Vote regarding Mr. McGoo's was also tabled, regarding safety issue outside property.

Budget proposals were discussed, including full staffing for the 50 Precinct, and for local Fire houses, 4 new typewriters for the 50th Precinct, and 2 new bicycles.

The committee discussed nominations for community service awards.

New Business: an owner of the Dubai Lounge spoke about his action plan to address a recent noise complaint. The owner stated that he will reduce noise by turning down volume.
