

**RESOLUTION FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

*Whereas*, the New York Main Street Program provides financial/technical resources to help New York State communities with their main street/ downtown revitalization efforts, and

*Whereas*, the New York Main Street program awards competitive grants ranging from \$ 50,000 to \$ 200,000 annually to stimulate reinvestment in mixed use (commercial/civic and residential) “main street” buildings or districts, and

*Whereas*, the New York Main Street Program is a match program with public funds paying no more than 50% of the anticipated cost and the local business or property owner applicant paying the balance, and

*Whereas*, the New York Main Street Program activities are limited to facade renovation, building renovation, creation of downtown anchors and streetscape enhancements, and

Whereas, the Kingsbridge-Riverdale-Van Cortlandt Development Corporation will be submitting application to the New York Main Street Program to act as the Local Program Administrator of funds and program for the “Kingsbridge Main Street Initiative” which will specify buildings and facade renovations within the targeted area consisting of the east side of Broadway from 232 Street to Verveelen Place, the west side of Broadway from 231<sup>st</sup> Street to 230<sup>th</sup> Street and the north side of 230<sup>th</sup> Street from Broadway to Godwin Terrace,

*Be It Resolved*, that Community Board 8 supports Kingsbridge-Riverdale-Van Cortlandt Development Corporation in their grant application from the New York State Main Street Program.
