Whereas, each committee reaffirms its commitment and endorsement in fully supporting the NYC Fire Department's recommendation to put an EMS garage station at West 230th St. & Broadway which would only require approximately 5,000 sq. ft.; and

Whereas, each committee fully endorses economic development at the same site and school health care services, conscious that dual projects can coexist, and seeks to enhance the community's school health care services and improve our economic growth; and

Whereas, the placing of an EMS garage station has been a necessity and priority for over 12 years in Community Board No. 8, and has taken that many years to find a place suitable to situate an EMS garage station, and we are fortunate that all proposals being considered for the site at West 230th St. & Broadway include at least 5,000 sq. ft. to place an EMS garage station; and
