An application for a new, full liquor license was made by A1 & J1 Restaurant, 5977 Broadway, a 24-hour restaurant at this location for approximately 35 years. The applicants said the hope was that the license would increase business and the agreed to stop serving at 2 a.m. There being no objections the application was approved unanimously.

An application for a renewal for a full liquor license and a letter for a 30-day waiver for the SLA due to an illness in the family was made by Five Kids Five Inc. DBA Riverdale City Grill, 3541 Riverdale Ave. The police complained of a number of underage drinking violations, with summons' issued to the youths rather than the bar. After a lengthy discussion of possible solutions, the representative of the establishment agreed to require a minimum age of 23 for service and to close at 2 a.m. for a year, and to come before the Committee at that time to ask for permission to close later. The application, and the letter, were then approved unanimously.
