Stephen Kaminsky - Delafield Avenue & Iselin Avenue

Can we get a Stop sign – this is a three-way intersection near schools and houses of  
worship.

3620 Oxford Avenue – Building has permits restricting parking but is under a Stop Work Order.  
Board will submit a letter to DOT and DOB requesting that the parking restrictions be removed  
until such time as work starts again.

Crosswalk at Riverdale Ave & West 239<sup>th</sup> Street (east of monument) – there is currently no  
crosswalk in place. Board will send a notice to DOT and DDC to see if this was an oversight as  
part of the bridge rehab.

The exit off the HHP at West 253<sup>rd</sup> Street arrow signs were hit and are damaged. This is an  
ongoing problem that needs to be addressed by DOT. Board to contact DOT to replace signs.

Four-Way Full Stop at Johnson Avenue and West 236<sup>th</sup> Street, (Traffic light needed??).

West 235<sup>th</sup> Street and Arlington Avenue – The ineffective traffic coordinators and the  
construction zone no parking area on the east side of Arlington is filled with cars of the  
construction workers. To be brought up with Land Use Chair.
