## **Board Resolution**

It is resolved that, unless and until the Board otherwise resolves:

- 1. The CCRB believes that it is legally entitled to obtain the grand jury evidence related to our investigation of the Eric Garner matter consistent with the litigation that CCRB initiated in Staten Island Supreme Court. We further seek to appeal that court's adverse decision to the Appellate Division, Second Department and, if necessary to the New York Court of Appeals. We respectfully request the support and representation of our lawyers at the New York City Law Department in pursuit of this appeal. If the Law Department does not wish to represent us, we respectfully request permission to represent ourselves and pursue this appeal. Of course, the CCRB will abide by the Law Department's final decision in this matter. Regardless of the outcome of the litigation, the CCRB will do everything in its power to continue its investigation into the death of Eric Garner.
