Introduced by Council Member Gerges and Council Member Leffler (by request of the Mayor); also Council Member Wooten.

A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to annual disclosure of financial interest by certain city employees.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph three of subdivision a of section 1106-5.0 of chapter forty-nine of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number forty-eight of nineteen hundred seventy-nine, is amended to read as follows:

3. Each agency head, deputy agency head, assistant agency head, member of any board or commission, other than a member of a board or a commission who serves without compensation, and each city employee who is a member of the management pay plan or whose salary on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-three was thirty-eight thousand dollars a year or more or whose salary on June thirtieth nineteen hundred eighty-four or on June thirtieth of subsequent years is forty-two thousand dollars a year or more shall file such report not later than July first of each year.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall apply to reports required to be filed for the calendar year commencing January first, nineteen hundred eighty-two and each calendar year thereafter. Any employee or former employee who earned a salary of less than thirty-eight thousand dollars on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-three and was not an agency head, deputy agency head, assistant agency head or member of the management pay plan and who filed a financial disclosure report covering the calendar year nineteen hundred eighty-two shall be entitled to a return of such report on file with the City Clerk. A request for the return of such report shall be made in writing by the employee and presented in person at the office of the City Clerk and must be accompanied by a letter from the employee's agency head stating that the employee earned a salary of less than thirty-eight thousand dollars on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred eighty-three.
