

Advisory Opinion No. 91-6

A public servant at the managerial level asked the Conflicts of Interest Board for an opinion as to whether it would be a conflict of interest under Chapter 68 of the City Charter for him to accept a \$200 honorarium for delivering a lecture to a college class which was not part of his official duties. The college has no business dealings with the public servant's agency. The public servant's agency head approved his acceptance of the honorarium.

It is our opinion that it would not be a conflict of interest under Chapter 68 for the public servant to accept the honorarium under these circumstances.
