

Advisory Opinion No. 92-1

A high-level appointed official has asked the Conflicts of Interest Board (the "Board") for an opinion as to whether, consistent with the conflicts of interest provisions of Chapter 68 of the City Charter, he may serve without compensation as a member of an advisory board which has no dealings with his agency. This advisory board makes written recommendations to other City agencies and, by statute, its members must include representatives of City agencies.

It is the opinion of the Board that it would not be a violation of Chapter 68 for the public servant to serve on this advisory committee, under the circumstances here described.
