Dear fellow New Yorker:

As you know, on February 6, the NYC Districting Commission adopted a revised plan for the boundaries of the fifty-one City Council districts in the City of New York. On February 8, the revised plan was delivered to the City Council for its consideration. Pursuant to New York City Charter Section 51(d), the revised plan was deemed “final” on March 1, 2013. Subsequently, on March 4, the Districting Commission filed the final plan with the City Clerk.

Today, the final districting plan is being forwarded to the United States Department of Justice for preclearance pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act, which covers the boroughs of Manhattan, Bronx and Brooklyn. As stated in the attached notice, a complete duplicate copy of the submission is available for public inspection at the office of the Districting Commission, 253 Broadway, 7th Floor, New York, New York. A complete copy of the submission is also available on the Districting Commission’s website at <http://www.nyc.gov/districting>. There, the submission can also be automatically translated into over 50 languages.

The Districting Commission encourages you to review the submission, and invites you to provide comments for the Attorney General’s consideration as the Department of Justice considers the Commission’s request for preclearance.
