

READ THE CITY'S ENDANGERED SPECIES LAW

SELLING OR BUYING PRODUCTS THAT USE INGREDIENTS FROM THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IS ILLEGAL

City law forbids the sale or purchase of products that list on the label that it contains any ingredients derived from any species that are declared endangered or threatened under New York law. This includes all species that are declared endangered or threatened under federal law, in addition to other species that have been declared by New York to be endangered or threatened.

All populations of the species listed below are declared endangered or threatened, and no product listing ingredients from any such animals may be bought or sold in New York City:

Rhinos
Tigers
Leopards
Sea turtles

The City has added a new rule, as Subchapter I, to Chapter 4 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York.
