

DCAS SPONSORS AN IDNYC POP UP SHOP!

IDNYC is a free identification card for all New York City residents. If you don't have your card yet, you can get one at a **pop-up enrollment site at 1 Centre Street!**

Dates: Monday, Sept. 19 to Friday, Sept. 23
Hours: Monday - Thursday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Friday, 9:00 am to 12:00 noon

How Can I Get My IDNYC?

1. Applicants are required to present proof of identity and residency. Go [here](#) for a list of documents that can be used to apply for the IDNYC card. Your DCAS/New York City employee ID is worth 2 points toward the 3 point identity requirement.
2. Bring your application and documents to **the Pre-bid room on the 18th floor of 1 Centre Street. No appointment is necessary, and walk-ins are welcome!** However, you can make an appointment [here](#).
3. Your IDNYC will be mailed to your home.

Why Should I Get an IDNYC Card? IDNYC gives you access to exclusive benefits and discounts across the City:

- Discounts at movie theaters, Broadway show, concerts and sporting events.
- Free one-year memberships at 40 of the city's best museums, zoos and botanical gardens.
- You can use your IDNYC card as a library card at any public library in New York City.
- Discounts on prescription drugs, and memberships with the YMCA, Citi Bike and the Parks Department.

DOES the IDNYC Card replace the DCAS/New York City employee ID?

No, the IDNYC Card is a separate ID card which provides many benefits to all New Yorkers. DCAS employees will still need to use their DCAS/New York City employee ID for electronic access to DCAS offices.
