## **The Henry Chang Memorial Center for Mechanical Engineering**

Today, the City's Mechanical Maintenance Operating Engineers based at the Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS), DCAS Commissioner Lisette Camilo and Department of Records and Information Services (DORIS) Commissioner Pauline Toole announced a plan to honor deceased City engineer, Henry Chang.

A section of the [Municipal Library](#) will be developed as a dedicated engineering resource and named for Chang, a revered and inspirational DCAS engineer. The Henry Chang Memorial Center for Mechanical Engineering will be equipped with specialized software, hard copy materials, and implements used to calculate potential energy savings. In developing the Chang Center, the Library staff will consolidate and make available existing materials on mechanical and civil engineering. The Operating Engineers, a voluntary group, will fund the software and engineering equipment. The Center is expected to open in November 2016.
