I. Under the heading OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER (015):

- A. To classify the following managerial titles in the Non-Competitive Class, subject to Rule X, Part I:

Investment Manager (Comptroller) (29 positions); and  
Director of Investments (Comptroller) (13 positions)

Part I positions are designated as confidential or policy influencing under Rule 3.2.3 (b) of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of New York and therefore are not covered by Section 75 of the Civil Service Law.
