NOTICE OF EXAMINATION

**PROMOTION TO PLUMBER (HHC)
 Exam. No. 7512
 (For The New York City Health and Hospital Corporation Only)**

<p>WHEN TO APPLY: From: August 1, 2007 To: August 21, 2007</p>	<p>APPLICATION FEE: \$60.00 <i>Payable by mail by money order to D.C.A.S. (EXAMS) or payable online by credit card, bank card, or debit card.</i></p>
<p>THE TEST DATE: The multiple-choice test is expected to be held on Saturday, November 10, 2007.</p>	

WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES: Plumbers, under supervision, perform work relating to the installation, alteration, maintenance, and repair of piping of gas, potable water, plumbing and drainage systems. They install, maintain and repair piping of all kinds for water, gas, storm, waste, soil and vent systems; set, maintain and repair plumbing fixtures, equipment and appurtenances; when necessary, determine and requisition job materials while work is in progress; supervise and are responsible for the work of Plumber's Helpers; in the temporary absence of the supervisor, may perform the duties of that position; operates a motor vehicle; and perform related work.

When assigned as a licensed plumber, Plumbers obtain written building permits for plumbing work to be performed; conduct and/or witness tests on plumbing and gas piping systems; prepare applications, reports, notices and other documents; and prepare sketches, drawings and layouts which may be required.

Some of the physical activities performed by Plumbers and environmental conditions experienced are: communicating orally in a noisy environment; working in extreme temperature conditions (hot or cold); climbing stairs, ladders, scaffolds and over equipment; walking over wet and slippery surfaces; moving heavy valves, piping and fixtures; carrying heavy objects such as tool boxes, pipe, and bags of pipe fittings; working in close spaces; using torches; and working in the vicinity of biohazards.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$42.41 per hour for a 35-hour week. This rate is subject to change.

HOW TO APPLY: If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, there are two ways to apply for this examination:

1. **Online at the DCAS WEBSITE:** If you wish to apply online, go to the Online Application System (OASys) at www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs and follow the onscreen application instructions for electronically submitting your application and completing any required forms. The following methods of payment are acceptable: major credit card, bank card associated with a bank account, or prepaid debit card which you may purchase online or at various retail outlets.
2. **By mail:** Refer to the "Required Form" section below for the form that you must fill out. Return the completed form and the application fee to DCAS Applications Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, New York, NY 10007.

ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATION: This examination is open to each employee of the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation who **on the date of the multiple-choice test:**

- (1) holds a permanent (not provisional) competitive appointment in or appears on a Preferred List (see Note, below) for the title of Plumber's Helper; and
- (2) is not otherwise ineligible.

(Note: A "Preferred List" is a civil service list which is only for certain former permanent incumbents of the eligible title who have rehiring rights.)

READ CAREFULLY AND SAVE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

If you do not know if you are eligible, check with **your facility's personnel office**. You may be given the test before we verify your eligibility. You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the eligibility requirements for this examination prior to submitting the application. If you are marked "Not Eligible," your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE PROMOTED: In order to be eligible for promotion, you must have completed your probationary period in the eligible title as indicated in the above "Eligibility To Take Examination" section, and you must be permanently employed in the eligible title or your name must appear on a Preferred List for the eligible title at the time of promotion.

REQUIRED FORM:

Application for Examination: Make sure that you follow all instructions included with your application form, including payment of fee. Save a copy of the instructions for future reference.

REQUIREMENT TO BE APPOINTED:

Driver License Requirement: You must possess a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York at the time of appointment. If you have moving violations, license suspension or an accident record, you may be disqualified. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

THE TEST: You will be given a multiple-choice test. A score of at least 70% is required to pass this test. Your score on this test will determine 85% of your final score. Your seniority will determine the remaining 15%. You must pass the multiple-choice test to have your seniority credited. Your seniority score will be 70 plus 1/2 point for each three months of completed, permanent, continuous service with the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation in competitive class titles. Your service will be credited through the date of the test, up to a maximum of 15 years. Time served prior to a break in service of more than one year will not be credited.

The Written Test Description: The multiple-choice test may include questions on: knowledge of materials and methods used in plumbing work; usage of tools, fittings and equipment of plumbing work; the Plumbing Section of the New York City Building Code; plan reading; mathematics; safety procedures; principles of supervision; and other related areas.

ADMISSION CARD: You should receive an Admission Card in the mail about 10 days before the date of the test. If you do not receive an Admission Card at least 4 days before the test date, you must go to the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, Manhattan, to obtain a duplicate card.

THE TEST RESULTS: If you pass the multiple-choice test and are marked eligible, your name will be placed in final score order on an eligible list and you will be given a list number. You will be notified by mail of your test results. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for promotion when your name is reached on the eligible list.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Selective Certification for Master Plumber License Or Certificate Of Competence: If you possess a Master Plumber license issued by the New York City Department of Buildings or a Certificate of Competence in Plumbing issued by the New York City Department of Buildings, you may be considered for appointment to positions requiring this license or the certification through a process called Selective Certification. If you qualify for Selective Certification, you may be given preferred consideration for positions requiring this license or certification. Follow the instructions given in the test booklet on the day of the test to indicate your interest in such Selective Certification. This requirement may be met at any time during the duration of the list. If you meet the Selective Certification requirement at some future date, please submit documentation by mail to: DCAS Bureau of Examinations UTEG, 1 Centre Street, 14th Floor, New York, NY 10007. Please include the examination title and number and your social security number in your correspondence. If you are appointed through Selective Certification, you must maintain your Master Plumber license or Certificate of Competence for the duration of your employment.

List Termination: The eligible list resulting from this examination will be terminated one year from the date it is established, unless extended by the NYC Health and Hospitals Corporation.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

Late Filing: Consult **your facility's personnel office** to determine the procedure for filing a late application if you meet one or more of the following conditions:

- (1) you are absent from work for at least one-half of the application period and cannot apply for reasons such as vacation, sick leave or military duty; or
- (2) you become eligible after the above application period but on or before the date of the multiple-choice test.

Special Test Accommodations: If you plan to request special testing accommodations due to disability or an alternate test date due to your religious belief, and you are applying:

- (1) **online**, follow the onscreen instructions; or
- (2) **by mail**, follow the instructions included with the "Application for Examination."

Make-up Test: You may apply for a make-up test if you cannot take the test on the regular test date for any of the following reasons:

- (1) compulsory attendance before a public body;
- (2) on-the-job injury or illness caused by municipal employment;
- (3) absence for one week following the death of a spouse, domestic partner, parent, sibling, child or child of a domestic partner;
- (4) absence due to ordered military duty; or
- (5) a clear error for which the Department of Citywide Administrative Services or the examining agency is responsible.

To request a make-up test, contact the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, New York, NY 10007, in person or by certified mail as soon as possible and provide documentation of the special circumstances.

The General Examination Regulations of the Department of Citywide Administrative Services apply to this examination and are part of this Notice of Examination. They are posted and copies are available in the Applications Center of the Division of Citywide Personnel Services, 18 Washington Street, NY, NY.
