The New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is in receipt of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's (DEC) January 23, 2015 letter containing your review comments on the Alley Creek LTCP. DEP submitted the LTCP to DEC on June 30, 2014, in accordance with the 2012 CSO Order on Consent. DEP requested a 45-day extension for the comment responses; DEC granted an extension to April 22, 2015. DEC granted an additional two weeks to May 6, 2015 to allow for further technical discussions surrounding the comments.
