Sometimes when there are heavy rains and the sewer system is at full capacity, a mixture of rain water and sewage, also known as combined sewage, is released into local waterways. To address combined sewer overflows (CSOs) in the Hutchinson River, the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is developing a Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) that will evaluate CSO controls, the related water quality benefits and associated costs.

Join us as we seek your input in the discussion on the proposed combined sewer overflow solutions and the related water quality benefits to the river and to you.
