Please join the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for the annual meeting of the NYC Green Infrastructure Citizens Group, of which the general public is a part and encouraged to attend. The Plan outlines how the City uses green infrastructure to improve the quality of NYC's waterways by capturing and retaining stormwater to reduce sewer overflows. The meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the Plan's implementation since its release on September 28, 2010.
