Job Description

The selected candidate will serve as Deputy Director, Water Demand Projections and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Analysis. Water Demand Projections and Analysis are used by the Department for many purposes, including water supply and wastewater infrastructure planning, assessing the effects of new growth and rezoning, and understanding the effects of water use on agency operations. As such, the selected candidate will assist the Director in working with a diverse group of professionals from many bureaus within the Department; assist the Director in gathering and organizing data, developing mathematical models to evaluate current and future water demands, storm water and wastewater flows consistent with planning, and other expressed needs of the organization; standardize and integrate data from multiple sources to improve model forecasts; and compare predictions to actual measured demands and flows. In addition, the candidate will make oral presentations.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of satisfactory full-time experience in city planning; *or*
2. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience that is equivalent to "1" above. Graduate education in city planning, urban planning, urban design, architecture, landscape architecture, transportation engineering, public administration, economic development or related fields may be substituted for experience on the basis of 30 graduate semester credits from an accredited college for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have a baccalaureate degree.

SQL Server, ArcGIS, and ACCESS. Familiarity with SPSS, SAS, or other statistical analysis packages preferred. The candidate must have extensive data analysis experience, urban planning and some background in water supply or wastewater infrastructure preferred.
