Job Description

The Staten Island Bluebelt is a system of streams, ponds and other wetland areas located in nineteen watersheds owned and managed by the New York City Department of Environmental Protection for the purposes of storm water management and open space preservation. The selected candidate for the position of Supervising Watershed Maintainer, under the direct supervision of the Bluebelt Field Manager, will be responsible for the supervising one or more supervisors and their crews in the day to day maintenance, repair and inspection of storm water ponds, outlet stilling basins, creek culverts and tributary storm water courses; and will supervise private contractors performing field maintenance work in storm water facilities owned by DEP. These contractors provide services such as mowing, snow removal, emergency tree removal, vactor work, debris removal and structural repair. In addition, the selected candidate will also perform routine inspections of storm water facilities and maintain records and reports of maintenance operations and should be familiar with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Freshwater and Tidal Wetlands regulations and procedures, and shall ensure that all active permits for field maintenance work remain in compliance at all times; will be responsible for coordinating field work activities with the New York City probation program and the United States Federal probation program; and will respond to weather related emergencies and ensure that all Agency regulations and safety procedures are properly in place and adhered to at all times.

Qualification Requirements

1. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent, plus three years of recent satisfactory experience in the operation, maintenance, repair, construction or inspection of facilities, equipment and lands in a watershed area, including aqueducts, reservoirs, water and/or waste water treatment plants; at least one year of which must have been in a supervisory capacity.
2. In addition to meeting the "Qualification Requirements" above, to be assigned to Assignment Level III, candidates must have four additional years of full-time satisfactory experience, as described above, at least two of which have been in a supervisory capacity, for a total of seven years of experience.

LICENSE REQUIREMENT- A Motor Vehicle Driver's License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

Familiarity with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Freshwater and Tidal Wetlands regulations and procedures.
