<b>Job Description</b>	
Working in the Distribution, Water Quality Field Operations, Lefrak Office, the selected candidate will report directly to the field supervisor and shall be responsible for collecting drinking water, quality compliance samples from sampling stations, hydrants, wells, and internal tap locations; testing field samples for pH, residual chlorine, orthophosphate, temperature and specific conductance; maintaining assigned field equipment and vehicles for optimum performance; recording results of analyses and investigations onto spreadsheets and handheld barcode scanners; assisting in water quality emergency remediation and field investigations as needed; and complying with all environmental, health and safety (EH&S) laws, rules and regulations.

A master's degree from an accredited college in one of the following areas of study: environmental or chemical engineering, limnology, environmental science, marine science, geology, biology, earth science, chemistry, physics, or health science; <i>or</i></p> <p>2. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college with 24 semester credits in one or a combination of the areas of study described in "1" above, at least 12 of which must have been in one of these areas of study; and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience, which may not have been part of graduate or undergraduate course work, working in the field of water quality planning, management or research or performing environmental laboratory analyses, and/or environmental field sampling of water;</p> <p>3.
